Dear Parents

At Hermitage Primary School we are committed to securing the best possible standards for the children in our care. Your child's class teacher continually reviews the progress of each child and acts to provide outstanding Quality First Teaching.

Quality First Teaching (QFT) provides children with the right amount of support, at the right time, with the correct level of challenge. It is an entitlement for all children. QFT may require the teacher to go over some concepts that children have not grasped, or to provide some children with different resources to make progress, or to promote a better understanding.

Quality First Teaching at Hermitage also includes the use of interventions. Interventions are bespoke group sessions of teaching, with a specific outcome, delivered by teachers or teaching assistants that aim to accelerate progress. These may be over a number of weeks, or they may involve pupils spending an extra 5 minutes to double-check a concept at the end of the lesson. These sessions may also be used to ensure pupils are challenged and extended in their learning. Children may be supported outside of the classroom, to provide a more focused environment but this is always done in a supportive way and is part of everyday school life.

Parents Evenings are scheduled for Monday 12th October and Wednesday 14th October and parents will be informed of the level of support their child is currently receiving.

Please rest assured that your child's safety and progress is of utmost importance to us and we will contact parents if we are concerned. If you are concerned about your child's progress please contact their class teacher.
